

Trouble Free Trailering Quick Checklist



- Get truck oil changed at appropriate intervals
- Check all tires (and spares) for tread and air pressure
- Check brakes and all trailer lights
- Check truck fluid levels – oil, antifreeze, transmission fluid
- Check lug nuts for rust and apply anti-seize product if necessary
- Check that all doors and/or windows are shut securely

Remember to Carry

- At least one spare tire each for truck and trailer
- Tire pressure gauge
- Trailer Aid or similar ramp
- Wheel chocks
- Hydraulic jack
- Tire iron (that fits truck and trailer lug nuts)
- Tool kit - crowbar, hammer, screwdrivers, wrenches, pliers
- Duct tape and electrical tape
- Jumper cables
- Spare fuses
- Fire extinguisher
- Flares/warning triangles
- Motor oil
- Water
- Antifreeze
- Tow rope
- Extension cord
- Flashlight
- WD-40
- Paper towels
- Gloves
- Baling twine (to catch a loose horse)
- Fencing pliers (to free a tangled horse)
